Before School

What is E-Safety

'E-Safety' is a term used to describe how we keep children safe when they are using any kind of technology- including the internet, mobile phones and computer games.

To help keep your children safe on the internet make sure they remember the SMART rules below:



S
Stay Safe
Don't give out your personal information to people / places you don't know.

M
Don't Meet Up
Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Always check with an adult you trust.

A
Accepting Files
Accepting emails, files, pictures or texts from people you don't know can cause problems.

R
Reliable?
Check information before you believe it. Is the person or website telling the truth?

T
Tell Someone
Tell an adult if someone or something makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.
