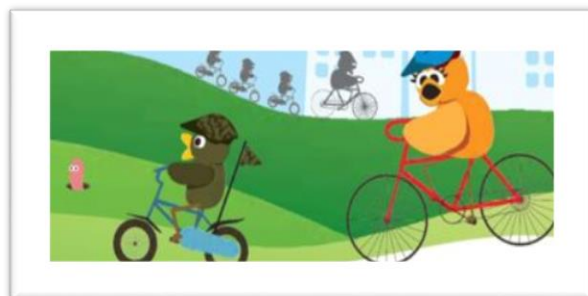
School Lunch Payments
