Home Challenge



Can you think about 1 more in your home, on the way to school, when out and about such as how many children are at the park and 1 more is? How many lamp posts do you see when you are walking down the street or travelling in your car? 1 more makes? At home how many stairs do you have...1 more makes? etcccc

How you can help at home:

- ✓ Practise name writing with your child. Can they recognise their name at home?
- ✓ Please read with your child as much as possible. Talk about the front cover first; what do the children think the story might be about? Then talk about the pictures before you read the words. What can you see? What do they think might happen next? Search for the keywords learnt so far: *the to I no and go*
- ✓ What objects and words can you think of that start with 'b' and 'f'?
- ✓ When you are walking to school, can you practise counting to 10? Can you practise counting to 20?
- ✓ Watch the story of the Gruffalo's Child and describe the characters.
